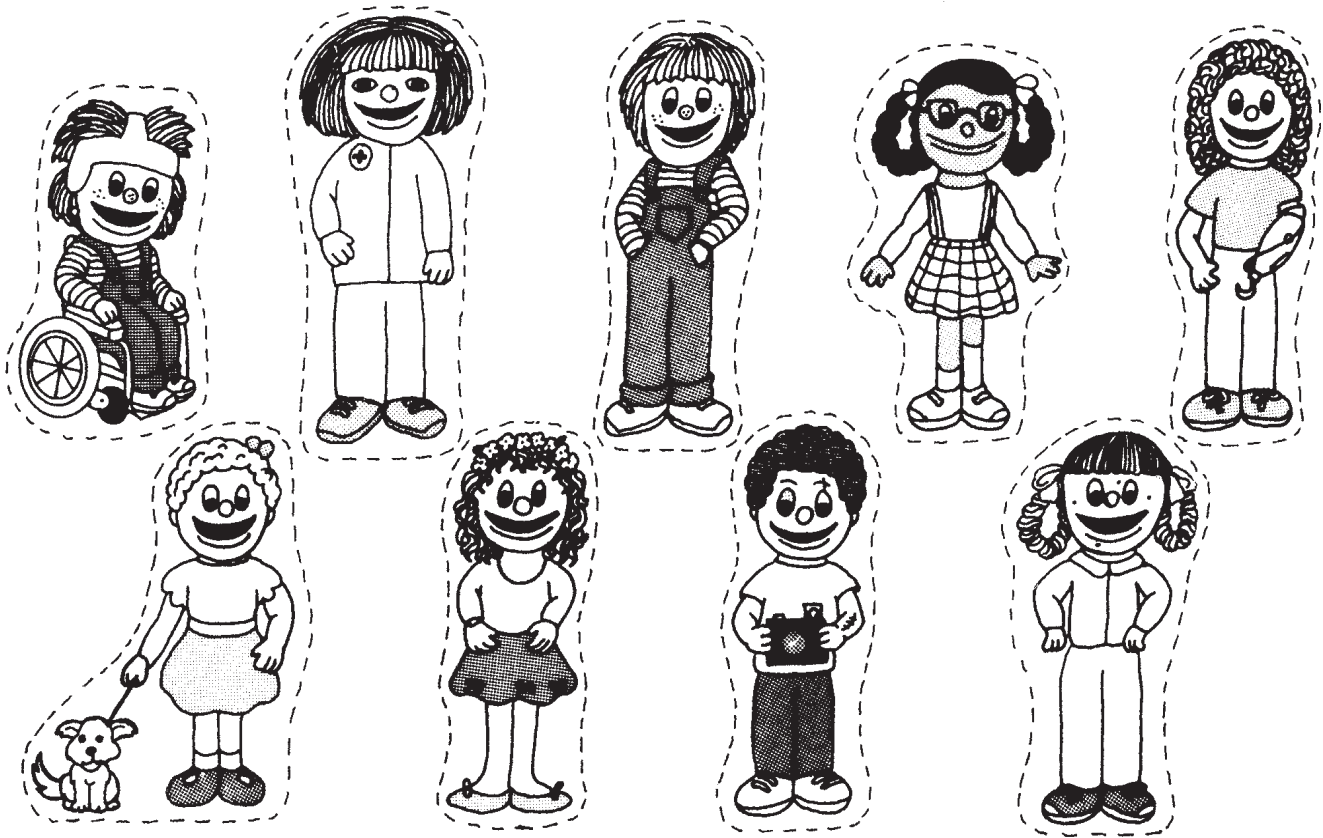


MEET SOME MORE OF THE KIDS ON THE BLOCK
