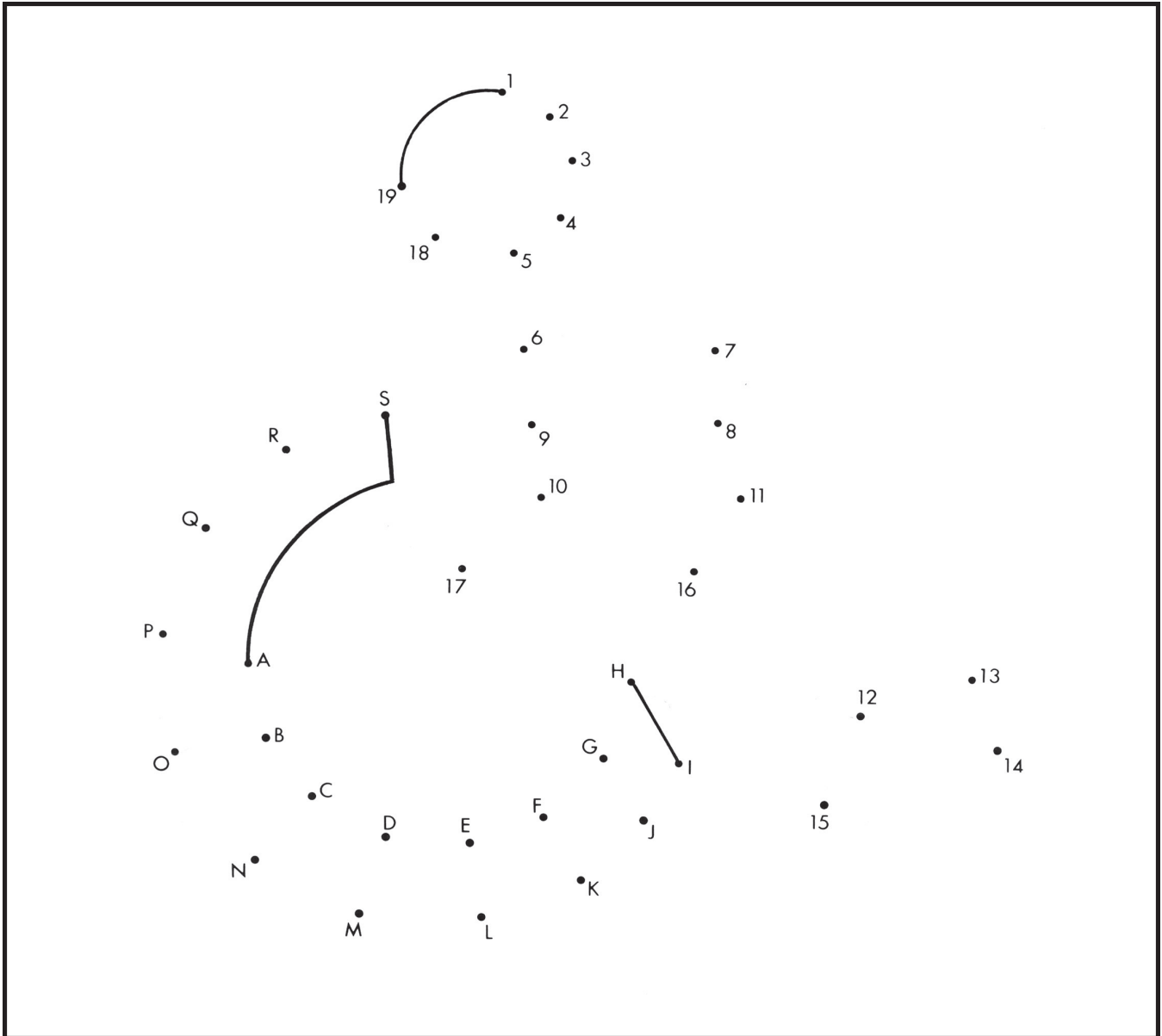


# SOMETHING IMPORTANT

There is a hidden picture below. Connect the dots to make a picture of something that many people with disabilities are happy to see.



Do you know what this picture is called? It is the symbol of access. When Mark sees it, he knows that his cruiser will be able to get into the building because there is a ramp close by. Valerie knows that there might be automatic doors so that she can get into the building, and both Mark and Valerie know there will be an accessible bathroom somewhere inside, too.
